


Who we are

APM Terminals Apapa took over the concession at Lagos' Apapa Container Terminal in 2006. In 2011, a USD \$135 million investment was announced for infrastructure and handling equipment, modernization of the terminals IT hardware and software systems and additional capacity.

In 2016, the addition of 4 RTGs increased the total number to 14. In 2020, two new mobile harbour cranes were acquired as part of an investment of USD80 million for the year 2020-2021, bringing the total investment by the company in Apapa since 2006 to USD438million (about N184billion), which is the highest by any private terminal operator in Nigeria, resulting in significant improvements in productivity, with zero waiting times for vessel berthing and a doubling of container volumes.

As Nigeria's largest container terminal, APM Terminals Apapa is a fast-paced, structured organization that is highly data centric, providing our customers with access to information that is required in making effective business decisions


Peeling / pre-stacking

Peeling addresses the problem of retrieving the desired container from a stack, by segregating the containers destined for a large beneficial cargo owner (BCO), or multiple BCOs, who agree to aggregate their containers into a single stack.

Cargo is consolidated in the yard for specific customers (importers, freight forwarders, trucking companies) and available for pick up in one shift. Containers are distributed from top of stack on one truck to the next truck, until all cargo is delivered. This results in significant improvements in cargo pick-up time.



Break bulk / Out Of Gauge (OOG) handling

APM Terminals Apapa has a specialist team and equipment ready to load and unload your Out-of-Gauge or Break Bulk Cargo. To ensure your valuable cargo always remains safe, we only use highly trained and experienced operators, and suitable equipment.

Break Bulk/Out OF Gauge significantly exceeds the size and/or weight of a standard container and is therefore handled as non-unitized cargo and normally placed on a bed of flat racks with a large number of lashing points. Break Bulk cargo includes things like equipment, industrial machines etc.



TERMVIEW / Track & Trace



APM Terminals Wallet

APMT Wallet is a prepayment plan that reduces the need for customers to raise invoices. The APMT Wallet system makes deductions from the customer's deposit account with APM Terminals, Apapa per container at gate out. It features an automated daily account and balance statement.

Other available features include self-update for applicable and additional charges on TERMVIEW. This is a great improvement over previous payment procedures as it addresses all payment related challenges.

- Seamless payment system for customers with routine & huge transactions.
- Transactional & Precise Billing: Payment is charged & deducted from your deposit account per container on each transaction (as soon as container is gated out).
- Eliminates the need for recurring payments and TDO revalidation and wrong rating dates, double payment, over payment, payment on wrong drafts etc.
- Payment is exact hence no excess storage due to overpayment as a result of unpredictability on a transaction.
- Not limited to working hours.

Real time cargo reporting



Dynamic TDO

 With respect to your feedback as part of our commitment to service improvement, we at APM Terminals have rolled out another impressive and faster process of generating TDO with multiple containers on the bill of laden (Dynamic TDO) and a faster process of loading your containers in the yard (Dynamic Delivery).



- Reduction of Waiting time during TDO generation for BL with multiple containers, as all the containers will be printed on one copy and copies re-printed for the number of containers on that BL
- Reduction of Truck waiting as containers will be loaded based on easy pick from a BL (this means that containers that can be easily loaded from a BL will be selected and loaded on your truck, thereby reducing waiting time for the trucker)
- Reduction of Truck inefficiency because containers free from all impediments (Government agencies hold, payment issue, etc.) on that bill of laden will be selected without delay
- Usual secured TDO. The Dynamic TDO also has a security feature, as it comes with a barcode that will improve the security of the TDO, as well as the transaction time at the gate


Reefer / cold storage facilities


APM Terminals Apapa is ready to meet the growing demand for year-round access to fruits, vegetables and other foodstuff . We have about 900 reefer plugs, constantly monitored and regulated to ensure goods are preserved at optimum temperature.

APM Terminals' availability of refrigerated facilities and its strategic location as the first port of call in Nigeria ensures deliveries to market are faster and more reliable than ever.

Our experience, along with dedicated customer care and flexible services means that APM Terminals Apapa can meet all your temperature-controlled cargo needs.

We have a 24-hour dedicated reefer desk to meet all demands on refrigerated cargo.





Barge handling services

At APM Terminals Apapa, we offer shipping lines, logistic service providers & shippers an extensive network of inland barge services through 3rd party barge operators all approved by the NPA. This is further enhanced by the provision of dedicated barge berthing space thus fostering barge services that directly connect the Apapa Port Terminal in Lagos with a growing number of strategically located jetties & Inland Container Depots (ICDs) in the Nigerian market.



- Reduces waiting time to access port as barges arrive port on scheduled visit.
- Cargo availability ahead of the competition.
- Improves customer cargo planning as barge slots are known to customer at least 72 hours earlier to barge arrival.
- · Reduces production down time.
- Reduces overall clearing cost.
- Fastest means of cargo delivery especially for extremely urgent cargo.

Rail handling services

APM Terminals Apapa is the only container terminal in Nigeria with a rail link to other parts of the nation. Using our rail service, congestion can be avoided leading to faster turnaround time for cargo. Our rail facilities mean that cargo can be loaded directly onto a train at our terminal to the hinterland.

In 2013, we restored a regular rail service, running three times per week to the inland cities of Kaduna, 730 km (455 miles) and Kano, 960 km (600 miles). In addition to making passenger rail travel from Lagos to Kano faster and safer in 2020, contracted and scheduled freight rail services were for the first time in a decade. In June 2020, two daily connections were introduced to Alagomeji Terminals in Yaba and Ijoko Terminals in Ogun State. Trucks can then be deployed to both locations to collect containers and return empties, which the NRC will convey back to the port.

Rail transport is quick and reliable – free of traffic jams - and is extremely suitable for heavy loads and dangerous transport. One train takes an average of 20 lorries off the road. By using rail transportation from the port, we shall all make freight transport more cost-efficient and also significantly reduce traffic congestion and the negative impact on the environment.





Inland services

APM Terminals Inland Services Nigeria has an inland container terminal (ICT) located in Kano, the commercial centre of northern Nigeria and its second largest city. It is the only ICT to have regular direct train services from Apapa.
