Overview

- TERMPoint Mobile APP
 - The new TERMPoint Mobile APP allows truckers and dispatchers to view, manage and cancel appointments
 - It is a primary appointment platform for truckers but also a supplementary platform for dispatchers who mostly work on PCs
 - Available in APP Store since June 30, 2020
 - To download, search TERMPoint in your Android or IOS store



Features

Drivers:


- See and manage appointments for my truck license (edit, cancel if granted permission)
- Get appointment tickets
- See Primary Truck License # and change Truck License # (if set up in TERMPoint desktop)
- Obtain terminal information

Dispatchers:


- See and manage appointments for my company (edit, cancel)
- Search and filter appointments
- See and send appointment tickets
- Obtain terminal information
- Available in English, Spanish, Italian

User Access and Set up Instructions



User Access


- Existing TERMPoint user?
 Log into the mobile app with your current TERMPoint username/password
- New TERMPoint user?

 Add new user in TERMPoint desktop. New user will receive email to set up password. Once set up, user can log in to mobile app with this login/ password.
- Optional user set up in TERMPoint desktop:
 - Want to limit users to view appointments only?
 Assign user to a user group with view only permissions
 - Want to limit user to see appointments for a specific truck license?
 Designate "Is Driver" and enter "Primary Truck #".



All mobile app users must be registered on TERMPoint Desktop

- To add a <u>new</u> user, click on Manage User & Add New User
 - New user will receive an email with directions to set up a password
 - After new user sets up password, they can download and log into the mobile app






Optional: Use Groups in TERMPoint desktop if you do not want drivers to be able to update or cancel appointments

- To create a new Group, click Manage User Groups
 - Set up user group with the permissions you want
 - Assign drivers to this user group

Example:

Drivers assigned to this group can view but cannot manage nor cancel appointments






Optional: Assign a primary truck license # to limit what appointments a driver will see in the mobile app

- In Manager User,
 - Click Is Driver
 - Add Driver's
 Primary Truck
 License #

Example:


Driver will see only appointments for truck license # 1132401 in the mobile app.


Driver can change this truck license # in the app if he/she is driving a different truck



Mobile App Examples- Logged in as **Dispatcher who has permission to update and cancel**

Can see all appointments and can update appointments





Mobile App Examples- Logged in as **Driver who is set** up with a primary truck license # 1132401

Can only see appointment for assigned truck license # 1132401
